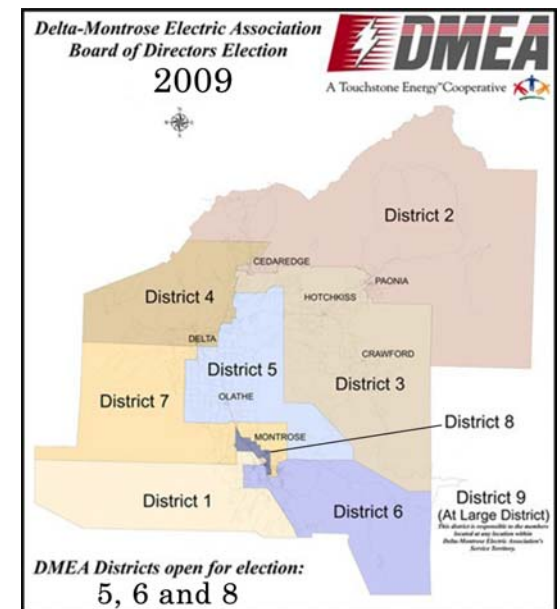

DMEA members interested in becoming candidates for the 2009 DMEA board of director election should note:

- ✓ This year DMEA districts 5, 6 and 8 are up for election. Please call DMEA to confirm the district in which you reside if you are interested in becoming a board candidate.
- ✓ Eligible members interested in running for DMEA's board must have been a member and have resided in their district a minimum of 45 days to become a candidate.
- ✓ **April 6, 2009** is the first day members interested in running for election can pick up petition packets needed to become a candidate.
- ✓ Petitions with 25 **member** signatures must be turned in to DMEA by **May 4, 2009** for the **petitioning member** to be on the 2009 election ballot.
- ✓ **DMEA's annual meeting will be held the evening of Thursday, June 18, 2009**, at the Montrose Pavilion. Registration and voting take place from 5-6:30 p.m. **The annual meeting will run from 6:30-8:30 p.m.**
